

# ST BONI MEMORIAL PARK COMMITTEE

Meeting Minutes October 6, 2018

Fred Keller opened the meeting at 9:08am. Members present: Fred Keller-SBACDG, St Boni Lions, Allen Hudinsky-Legion Commander, Pat Gorman-Westonka JC's, W. Jay Gregg-Historical Society, Carolyn Brooks-SBACDG, St Boni Lions

Minutes were read and there were no corrections or objections.

Restoration of Electrical Service, Mike's Electric has been approved by the City, waiting for them to proceed, the Christmas lights could be at Public Works and Fred will check,

Account has been established with the city and current balance of \$3800. Thank You to the JC's for the \$2,000 donation. The Resolution from the City was reviewed. Discussion on how the account will fund different parks, if someone donates for a particular park or item within the park the group cannot change that. Fred will speak with the City Council about moving funds from the Missile Park Veterans Memorial Park to the St Boni Memorial Park. Does the City donate to this cause? We will look for clarification on that.

Don Logelin Shelter (Lions) - nothing new

Memorial Park Play Area (City Action) - the Merry Go Round, what is City doing with it?

Patio (Legion & Sportsman Club) - Allen will bring pricing info next meeting. Discussion around the patio appearing that it would be more for the Community Center use, not for park visitors. If there was an event taking place at the Community Center would a park visitor feel comfortable using the patio next to the Community Center? Is that the best place for a patio in the green space? As the park is three areas there will be signs that designate the patio, Don Logelin shelter, and the green space where the gazebo, etc, will be as the Memorial Park. Or, we could add an additional picnic area in the green space?

Paver Walkway - waiting for additional plans on walkway and gazebo

Rain Garden - Don Heywood is heading this, Carolyn Brooks will be assisting  
Run-Off Pond - Don Heywood is heading this, Carolyn Brooks will be assisting

Gazebo - Fred presented a picture of a Gazebo that looked good yet inexpensive to build, he will take this to the Lions. He also knows 2 gentleman that are good carpenters to assist in building. Funds are set aside for this from Wilsey and Logelin donations.

2 Planting Beds - KC's

River Birch in NW Corner - will be in limbo until Spring - Superior suggested this type of tree

Memorial Park Sign - roof plans were described by Jay, he will pre-build and will bring to set, 6" steel pipes, 2 x 12 wrap around ends, soffits, 4 LED lights that will shine down upon the sign as opposed to shining up towards the sign. If Tony cannot get it done Jay will. The plan is to have the roof set on and the sign raised the week of 10-29. Roof plan is to be 8 to 9 feet long.
